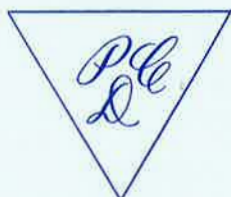

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF Z. D. BONNER

Z. D. Bonner, president and chief executive officer of Gulf Oil Company — U.S. is a native of San Antonio, Texas. He was graduated in 1941 from the University of Texas with a degree in chemical engineering.

He began his career with the firm in 1941 at its Port Arthur Refinery. Following World War II, he was discharged as a lieutenant commander and rejoined Gulf at Port Arthur.

His experience includes assignments in the Technical Service Department, the Gulf Patent Department in Washington, D.C., an assistant foreman in the Technical Survey Department, and assistant to the coordination director.

Mr. Bonner was named vice president, Pacific Gulf Oil Company, Ltd., in 1958. He moved to London in 1961 as manager, then vice president, of the Crude Oil Department of Gulf Eastern Company and coordinator, Special Projects.

In 1966, he was named president and chief executive officer of Goodrich-Gulf Chemicals, Inc., Cleveland. He returned to Gulf Oil Corporation in April 1970 as director of Corporate Development, and became president of Gulf Oil Chemicals Company in August of that year. He was elected an executive vice president of the corporation in May, 1973 and was appointed president and chief executive officer of Gulf Oil Company — U.S. in October, 1973.
