

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF JACK B. ST. CLAIR

Jack B. St. Clair is President of Shell Chemical Company, a division of Shell Oil Company, and Executive Vice President for Manufacturing-Transportation-Marketing and a Director of Shell Oil Company.

A graduate of Tulane University, New Orleans, La., in chemical engineering,

Mr. St. Clair joined Shell in 1940 as a technologist at the Houston, Tex., refinery. He held subsequent positions in Head Office (then in New York City), and at the Wood River, Ill., refinery before being appointed Assistant Manager, Technological, in the Head Office Manufacturing Department in 1954. Two years later he transferred to the Martinez, Calif., refinery as Assistant Superintendent. He became Superintendent at the Wilmington-Dominguez Calif., refinery in 1958, and he returned to the Houston refinery as superintendent in 1961.

Later in 1961, he accepted the post of Head of the North American Division

of Shell International Petroleum Company, His headquarters were in London. He returned to Shell Oil Company as General Manager, Technical Department, Manufacturing Organization, in 1963, and held that post until February 1965 when he accepted a six-month assignment as a member of the Public Affairs Fellowship Program of the Brookings Institution in Washington, D.C. In July 1965 he was named General Manager, Transportation and Supplies. He was elected Vice President — Transportation and Supplies in 1966.

Mr. St. Clair was named President of Shell Chemical Company and a Director

of Shell Oil Company on August I, 1967. In July 1971 he was elected Executive Vice President Shell Oil Company,

and in July 1973 assumed the duties of the Executive Vice President, Manufacturing-Transportation-Marketing.
St. Clair and his wife, the former Jean Dauernheim of Brooklyn, New York, make their home at 10907 Walwick, Houston, Tex. They have three children— Barbara Jean, Glenn Richard and Nancy Lynn.
