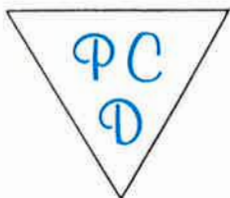

DAVID M. RODERICK

President

U. S. Steel Corporation

David M. Roderick, president of U. S. Steel Corporation, is a native of Pittsburgh and was graduated from the University of Pittsburgh in 1956 with a B.S. degree in economics and finance. He previously attended Oliver High School and was graduated from Robert Morris Junior College.

Mr. Roderick began his career with Gulf Oil Corporation and served with the Marine Corps during World War II. He was assistant comptroller of the Bessemer and Lake Erie

Railroad Company and the Union Railroad Company prior to joining U. S. Steel in 1959 as assistant to the director of statistics in the New York office.

In January, 1962, he was named accounting consultant-international projects, and he and his family lived in Paris, France, during this assignment. He became vice president-accounting, international in 1964 and was promoted to vice president-international in September, 1967. Mr. Roderick was named chairman-finance committee in March, 1973 and was elected president effective August 1, 1975.

Mr. Roderick is a director of Aetna Life & Casualty Company, the Tax Foundation, Inc., United Way of Allegheny County, the Regional Industrial Development Corporation of Southwestern Pennsylvania and the Pittsburgh Symphony Society. He serves on the Board of Trustees of Mercy Hospital, Carnegie-Mellon University and Shadyside Academy and is executive vice president-finance and member of the Executive Board, Allegheny Trails Council Boy Scouts of America.

He is also a member of the International Council of Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York, a member of the Citizens' Sponsoring Committee of the Allegheny Conference on Community Development, the Pennsylvania Society, American Iron & Steel Institute, New-comen Society and the Economic Club of New York.
