RICHARD J. MAHONEY



Richard J. Mahoney is an executive vice president and a member of the Board of Directors of Monsanto Company; St. Louis Missouri. He is also a member of the company's Corporate Administrative Committee. As executive vice president he is responsible for three operating units of the corporation — Monsanto Plastics & Resins Company, Monsanto Agricultural Products Company, and Monsanto Industrial Chemicals Company and, additionally, the International Division of Monsanto.

Born January 30, 1934, in Springfield, Mass., Mr. Mahoney was graduated from the University of Massachusetts in 1955 with a B.S. degree in chemistry.

He joined Monsanto in Springfield in 1962 as Product Development Specialist and subsequently held various sales, engineering and technical service positions. In 1965 he became Market Manager for new products for the former Plastic Products & Resins Division. In 1967 he was named Market Manager, bonding products, and later that year was appointed division sales director, plastic products, in Kenilworth, N.J.

Mr. Mahoney moved to St. Louis and became Sales Director for the Agricultural Division in 1971; in 1972 he was named Director of Sales for the Division. In 1974 he was appointed director, operations — international, for Monsanto Agricultural Products Company, and became General Manager of its Overseas Division in 1975. He was elected a Corporate Vice President and named Managing Director of Monsanto Agricultural Products Co., in October, 1975; Group Vice President and Managing Director of Monsanto Plastics & Resins Company in 1976; Executive Vice President in 1977; and was elected to Monsanto's Board of Directors in March, 1979.

He is a member of the Board of Directors of First National Bank of St. Louis, a member of the Advisory Board of St. John's Mercy Medical Center, a member of the Chancellor's Council of the University of Missouri — St. Louis, and was the 1979 Campaign Chairman of the area's Arts & Education Fund Drive.

Richard and his wife Barbara have three children.
