KONRAD M. WEIS

Konrad M. Weis is President and Chief Executive Officer of the Pittsburgh-based management holding company Bayer USA Inc.

A naturalized U. S. citizen, Dr. Weis was born in Leipzig, Germany, in 1928. He studied at the University of Bonn and received his Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry in 1955. That same year he began his professional career at Bayer AG of West Germany. Until he came to the United States in 1971, he held various research, production and staff positions at Bayer AG. Dr. Weis was elected President and Chief Executive Officer of Mobay Corporation in 1974. He held that position until July 1, 1986, when he began devoting full time to his new responsibilities at Bayer USA Inc.

Dr. Weis is a Director of Cyclops Corporation, Dravo Corporation, Compugraphic Corporation, PNC Financial Corp., and Pittsburgh National Bank.

In addition, he is also a Director and member of the Finance Committee of the Chemical Manufacturers Association, a member of the Policy Committee of the Pennsylvania Business Roundtable, a Vice President of the Allegheny Conference on Community Development in Pittsburgh, and a Trustee of Penn's Southwest Association.

He is also a member of the Board of Trustees of Carnegie-Mellon University and the Carnegie Institute in Pittsburgh, which is comprised of the Museum of Art and the Carnegie Museum of Natural History. In addition, he is a member of the Board of the World Affairs Council of Pittsburgh.

PITTSBURGH CHEMICAL DAY

Pittsburgh Chemical Day was established in 1968 to draw attention to the city of Pittsburgh as one of the nation's leading centers of chemical industry commerce. The attendance is comprised of various levels of chemical management in marketing, sales and purchasing. Every major U.
