HELGE H. WEHMEIER

Helge H. Wehmeier, President and Chief Executive Officer of Miles Inc., formerly Bayer USA Inc., was born in Goettingen, Germany in 1942.

Mr. Wehmeier joined Bayer AG, Leverkusen, Germany in 1965. He was transferred in 1969 to Mobay Corporation's New York office where he was responsible for the marketing of synthetic fibers in the United States and Canada.

In 1974, Mr. Wehmeier returned to Germany to manage the marketing organization of the company's Fibers Division for Scandinavia and the British Isles. In 1981, he became manager of the Organic Chemicals Division and in 1984 was transferred to Bayer AG's wholly owned subsidiary, Agfa-Gevaert AG, in Leverkusen, Germany, where he headed the Industrial Photographic Division.

Mr. Wehmeier became a member of the Board of Management of the Agfa-Gevaert Group in July 1987, with responsibility for Agfa's worldwide consumer products division.

In January 1989, Mr. Wehmeier was named President and Chief Executive Officer of the newly formed Agfa Corporation, Ridgefield Park, NJ. At that time, he also was elected to the Board of Directors and Executive Committee of Bayer USA Inc.

On July 1, 1991, Mr. Wehmeier was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer of Bayer USA Inc. (Bayer USA Inc. was reorganized and renamed Miles Inc. effective January 1, 1992.)

Mr. Wehmeier has attended numerous business programs in Europe, including the International Management Development Institute (IMEDE), Lausanne, Switzerland, and the Institut Europeen d'Administration des Affaires (INSEAD) in Fontainebleau, France.

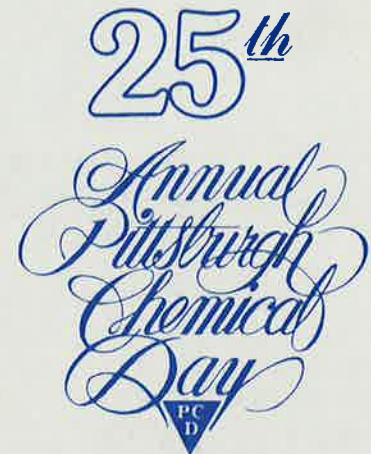
Twenty-Fifth Year
